


## THE ST. LOUIS


The St. Louis family of poles were originally designed for use in many districts of this famous city on the Big Muddy. Originally called "The Granitoid Poles", StressCrete has reproduced this family in exacting detail. The two design variations are available from 5' to 22' mounting heights.
